

Location

Halesowen lies approximately 7 miles from Birmingham City Centre and is just minutes away from junction 3 of the M5 motorway, giving access to the greater motorway network all around the West Midlands. The History of Halesowen stems back as far as the Anglo Saxons and it was listed in the Domesday Book as being larger than Birmingham. It forms part of the southern edge of the Black Country and during the industrial revolution it became synonymous with nail and screw making, an industry that still survives to a lesser extent today. Despite its proximity to the Black Country it still retains areas of beauty. Leasowes Park is thought to be one of the first natural landscaped gardens in England. Certain areas of the town have retained a certain number of Victorian houses but further development during the 1960's and 70's saw the building of several large housing estates. It has a number of highly sought after primary and secondary schools. Whilst Halesowen no longer has a train station of its own, the Worcester to Birmingham line passes along the northern edge of its boundary and the stations of Cradley Heath, Old Hill and Rowley Regis are all within a few miles of the town centre. Halesowen's bus station is a busy interchange and a regular service runs to Birmingham City Centre.

Approach

Via slabbed and stone chipping driveway, front lawn, side gate access to rear, access to garage, steps to double glazed panelled front door to:

Entrance porch

Double glazed window to side, door to:

Lounge 15'1" x 10'9" (4.6 x 3.3)

Double glazed window to front, central heating radiator, coving to ceiling, feature gas fire, wooden fireplace surround, opening to stairs to first floor accommodation and door to:











Kitchen diner 18'4" x 8'6" (5.6 x 2.6)

Two double glazed windows to rear, central heating radiator, double glazed obscured side door to rear garden, door to storage cupboard, range of matching wall and base units, complementary roll top surfaces over, one and a half bow sink, drainer and mixer tap, splashback tiling, integrated oven, four ring gas hob, extractor fan over, plumbing for washing machine, integrated fridge.

First floor landing

Double glazed obscured window to side, central heating radiator, access to loft space, door to shelved storage cupboard and further doors radiating to:

Bedroom one 11'9" excluding wardrobes x 9'10" (3.6 excluding wardrobes x 3.0)

Double glazed window to front, central heating radiator, coving to ceiling, fitted wardrobes.

Bedroom two 10'5" max 9'2" min x 9'10" (3.2 max 2.8 min x 3.0)

Double glazed window to rear, central heating radiator.

Bedroom three 8'2" x 8'10" (2.5 x 2.7)

Double glazed window to front, central heating radiator, coving to ceiling.

Bathroom

Double glazed obscured window to rear, coving to ceiling, central heating radiator, tiled walls, panelled bath with shower over and shower screen, pedestal wash hand basin.

Separate w.c.

Double glazed obscured window to side, low level flush w.c.

Rear garden

Slabbed patio area, steps to lawn, plant beds, fence panel boundaries, side gate access to front.

Garage 16'4" x 8'2" max 7'2" min (5.0 x 2.5 max 2.2 min)

Up and over door, lighting and electrics, housing central heating boiler.
