

77 Exchange Road, West Bridgford, NG2 6BX


This bay fronted period home sits in a highly convenient central West Bridgford location with practical driveway parking to the side for a small vehicle. The property enjoys excellent access to local amenities, with Central Avenue less than a two-minute walk away, while nearby Twitchell provides a direct route to Gordon Road's popular selection of bars, restaurants and shops.

The accommodation begins with an entrance hall leading to a generously sized bay fronted living room featuring high ceilings with coving and a gas fireplace. The separate dining room also includes a gas fire and connects to the kitchen, which has a side door providing access to the rear garden. On the first floor, the master bedroom extends across the full width of the house, complemented by two additional bedrooms and a shower room.

A notable feature is the large loft space, which offers the potential for conversion into a fourth bedroom with en-suite facilities, subject to obtaining the necessary planning permissions. The property does require comprehensive updating and modernisation throughout, but this presents an opportunity to create a comfortable family home in this well-regarded location.

The house benefits from gas central heating and double glazing, providing essential infrastructure for any future improvements. With no upward chain, the property offers a straightforward purchasing process for buyers looking to renovate and modernise a period home in this desirable West Bridgford setting.
