Once serving as one of Pershore's telephone exchanges in 1905, the property boasts a rich history, complemented by stunning architectural details.

Inside, the heart of the home is the bespoke-fitted Jeremy Penman kitchen, featuring an electric Aga and handcrafted storage cupboards. The dining room, bathed in natural light from its striking lantern roof window, offers delightful views of the generous south-facing garden. The spacious 18'8 x 16'3 sitting room exudes warmth with its wood-burning stove, exposed beams, and inviting atmosphere. A downstairs cloakroom, attic room, and cellar provide additional practicality and storage.


Upstairs, the master bedroom benefits from an en-suite shower room, while the remaining bedrooms maintain the home's charming character.

Pershore has Number 8 which is run by voluntary help and provides theatre activities, a cinema, ballet and yoga classes and is very much a part of Pershore community living.










