Upon entry, you are welcomed into a spacious reception hallway with stone floor tiles and a solid oak staircase. To the left, there is a recently refitted ground floor WC and a useful laundry room. The flooring transitions to reclaimed oak, which continues through to a formal dining room with doors opening onto the rear terrace.

To the right-hand side, the dual-aspect living room features an imposing Inglenook fireplace with stone mantel surround and a wood-burning stove, along with built-in storage. The kitchen, located off the hallway, is fitted with bespoke wooden cabinetry, granite worktops, a central island, a double Belfast sink, and integrated appliances. This space also benefits from direct access to the rear terrace and pleasant garden views.

The first-floor landing offers a flexible area suitable for a study or hobby space. There are four generously sized double bedrooms, some of which include fitted wardrobes. The principal bedroom has a recently updated en suite with high-quality Villeroy & Boch fittings throughout. A well-appointed family bathroom with both a bath and shower completes the first floor.

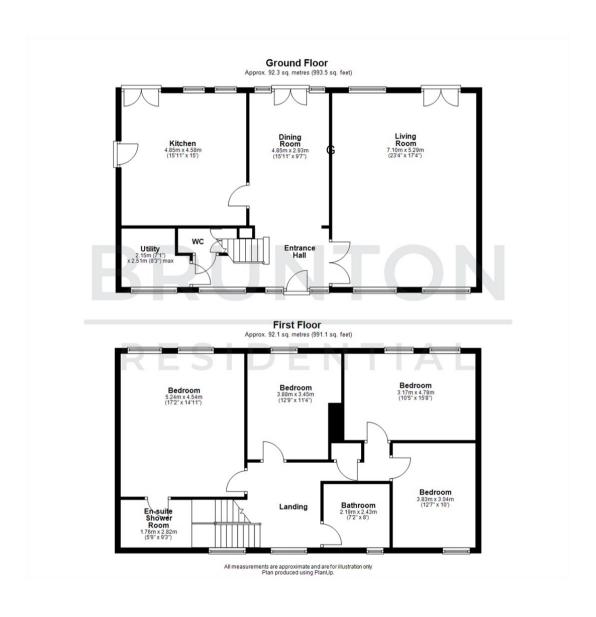
